YOUNG ADULT

We are seeing an increased number of young adults and their families joining Macedonia and we are grateful. With the help of the co-lead Geneva Anderson we have made sure we have contacted each of the new people and made sure to invite them to be a part of the ministry. This year we have maintained at least two fellowship gatherings each month. These fellowships have ranged from bonfires to Sunday brunches. Our focus was to build a stronger foundation for the young adult age group at Macedonia. TEENS
